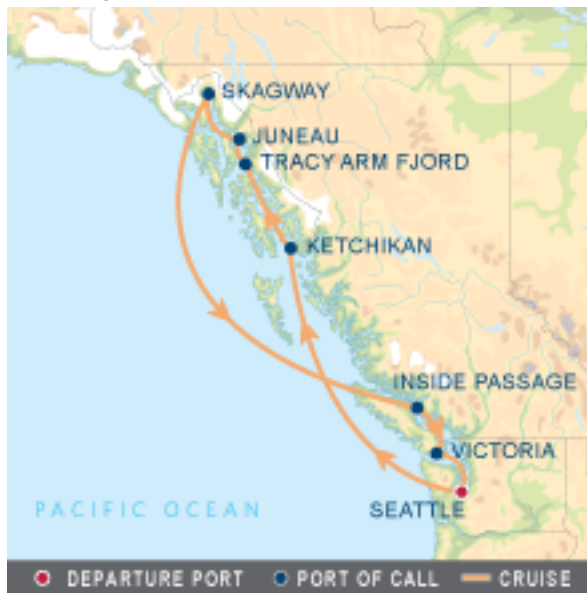

Day 1 - Seattle, Washington – Embarkation & Departure

Today proceed on your own to the pier. Following embarkation procedures, you may board “The Infinity,” your floating home for the next seven nights. (Please schedule your arrival at the ship between 12:00 – 3:00 PM for boarding)

4:00 PM The Infinity sets sail.

Day 2 - At Sea

Enjoy a full day to cruise and take in the awesome beauty of the Pacific Northwest coastline and become acquainted with all the onboard activities on The Infinity.

Day 3 - Ketchikan, Alaska – Port of Call

7:00 AM “Salmon Capital of the World,” KETCHIKAN, is as picturesque as they come. The town is built on piles out over the water and clings to the slopes of Deer Mountain. Look around this charming town on your own and visit picturesque Creek Street – once the town’s “Red Light” district. Native culture abounds at Saxman Village and Totem Bight State Park.

4:00 PM All aboard ... the Infinity departs.

Day 4 - Cruising Tracy Arm Fjord / Juneau – Port of Call

6:00 AM – 10:00 AM This morning cruise through TRACY ARM, a 26 mile narrow, winding fjord that was once a glacier-filled valley and now lined with ice carved walls rising thousands of feet on each side. Marvel at the countless number of waterfalls appearing at each turn of this spectacular fjord.

2:30 PM Welcome to Alaska's scenic capital ... JUNEAU. Situated between the towering Mt. Juneau and Gastineau Channel, the city combines the modern architecture of high rise buildings with the renovated structures of the Gold Rush Historic District. A fascinating place to explore.

10:00 PM The Infinity weighs anchor.

Day 5 - Skagway / Inside Passage – Port of Call

7:00 AM Arrival in SKAGWAY ... a picturesque gold rush town with a main street lined by a row of false-fronted buildings and boardwalks. Step back into history at the Trail of '98 Museum, sightsee aboard the narrow-gauge White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad, or try sportfishing, mountain biking, or flightseeing. Shoppers will find everything from native crafts to scrimshaw carvings and jewelry.

8:30 PM All aboard ... your ship departs Skagway.

8:30 PM – 11:59 PM Spend your evening cruising the protected waters of the Inside Passage past countless islands, evergreen forests, and a continual procession of birds and sea mammals. This area is the traditional home of the Tlingit, Haida, and Tsimshian Indians.

Day 6 - At Sea

Day 7 - Victoria, British Columbia – Port of Call

A day free for activities of your own choosing.

Ports of Call

Seattle, Washington

The Emerald City combines spectacular natural beauty and cosmopolitan flair like few places can. An outdoor and coffee mecca, Seattle also offers up some of the best seafood anywhere along the Pacific Rim. Named after the great chief of the Suquamish Indians, Seattle enjoys a fusion of American, Asian and Native American cultures you won't likely find anywhere else.

Ketchikan, Alaska

In addition to being the jumping-off point for seaplane excursions into the Misty Fjords National Monument and its 2.2 million acres of wilderness nirvana, Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit tribe. Another "must-see" here is the world's largest collection of totem poles. You can learn what motivates someone to turn a piece of lumber into a towering work of art at the Saxman Native Village and Totem Bight and Totem Heritage Center.

Tracy Arm Fjord, Alaska

Amidst the pure silence, you'll sail past translucent blue icebergs silhouetted against a most dramatic backdrop of waterfall-laced rock walls ascending thousands of feet into the sky. This classic fjord, Tracy Arm extends over 30 miles and once seen, it is never to be forgotten.

Juneau, Alaska

Where Earl Grey meets Eddie Bauer® would be a good way to describe the charms of Alaska's capital city. Here the pioneering spirit lives on in an interesting mix of cosmopolitan chic and frontier ruggedness. Visit the Alaska State Museum and its exquisite collection of Russian Orthodox and Gold Rush relics.

Skagway, Alaska

It's doubtful you'll succumb to gold fever, but if any place on earth can summon up the thrill of prospecting, it's Skagway. By embracing its gold-rush past, Skagway has managed to preserve a frontier spirit complete with saloons and dance-hall revues. If the spirit does overtake you, passage on the White Pass & Yukon Railway or a ride on the Klondike Highway will take you to places where you can roll up your sleeves and do some prospecting of your own.

Inside Passage (Cruising)

This is one of the most famously beautiful passages in all the world. It features virtually everything you came to Alaska hoping to see, including rain forests, glaciers, fjords and white-capped peaks. All of which create a setting that's perfect for viewing whales and sea lions.

Victoria, British Columbia

The capital of British Columbia is also its largest island. This one-time British colony has retained much of its colonial splendor. Victoria is a seaside enclave that enjoys a temperate climate. FAQs

• What time do I have to be onboard ship?

Passengers have to be onboard and checked in at least 2 hours prior to the 4:00 PM departure.

• If my flight is done independently, what do I need to know ?

In order to transfer from the Seattle airport to the ship, the flight arrival into Seattle airport needs to be by 1:00 PM and the earliest flight to be booked for a return on July 16 is at 12:00 noon.

• How far is the airport from the port?

It takes about 15-30 minutes to get to the cruise terminals from Sea-Tac Airport. Taxi fares can range from \$25 - \$40 from the airport to downtown.

• What about transfers from the airport to the port, how much is that?

Cost of transfers through the cruise line is \$62.00 per person roundtrip and \$31.00 one way. But, if you book your air with

Celebrity, the transfer is included.

• **Where can I book air and/or hotel?**
